Dear participants of the DAY OF EUROPEAN AUTHORS (27/3):

As the celebration of the Day of European Authors is getting closer (next Monday, 27th of March), we have prepared, in coordination with the Commission and the Directorate Education and Culture, as well as with the Consortium of the European Union Prize for Literature (EUPL), some guidance for your public communication, and have prepared for all authors individual images and a dedicated website:

Under the OneDrive Link VISUALS DEA you find several folders. Two are most useful:

- <u>INDIVIDUAL SQUARE POSTS</u> Individual Square png these ready-made-images are for postings on your social media channels. You find your personalised canva in the official frame of the Day of European Authors.
- A folder named <u>toolkit</u> with: - e-mail image signature
 - a blank frame
- Useful for your school: a power point template for A4 Posters. These can be filled out according to your own wishes, printed out and used, for example, as an event poster.


VISUALS AND WORDING FOR PARTCIPATING ORGANISATIONS

Visuals:

- If you use a ready-made frame with "your" author(s) by us, please take care, that any added logo by your organisation has to be inside the frame, and not on it.
